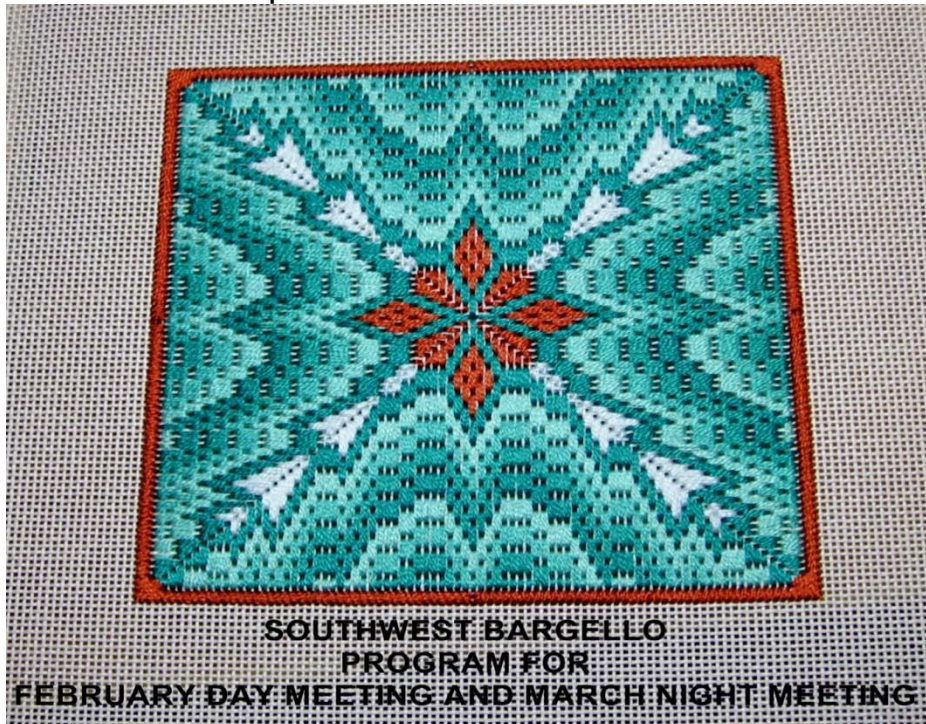
February: Jan Sprague will present Four Way Bargello. This is an exciting use of this style and very versatile. Supplies needed:

5 values of your favorite color. The lightest value should have a lot of contrast to the darkest value.

1 contrasting color

This will be a small project (approx 4 1/2"x4 1/2") so less than a skein of each color is required.
