SATURDAY-SUNDAY FEBRUARY 23-24 TEAPOT

DIRECTIONS: From River Rd: go East past The West. Turn LEFT onto TANURI. It curves around and you will drop down to your left. After a few more curves you will come to a T-intersection. Turn RIGHT onto Via Colorado. You will go up a steep hill divided by bushes and up at the top is a stop sign. Turn RIGHT onto Del Bribon and the Rec center is at the end of the block on the right. There is a frig, microwave and pool!

TUESDAY-WEDNESDAY February 26-27 TUCSON PATCH

Classes will be held at Christ the King Episcopal Church, 2800 W. Ina Rd. Coming from the east side of town, on Sunrise go past Foothills Mall, past MONA LISA, over a wash and on your right or North side you will see Nanni Library /Sheriff's Dept. Turn in there taking an immediate left around the church. Our classroom is in the bottom of the church. IF YOU GO TO SHANNON, you have gone too far.
