November: Combined Potluck Meeting on Saturday, November 14th. We will be working on the notebook covers. The Pima County Medical Society

will be open at 9:30am so we can start the workshop promptly at 10:00 a.m.

Please bring the following items to the workshop:

The following items can be found at Paper Paper Paper located at 3130 E. Fort Lowell Tucson, AZ 85716. This is the Southeast corner of Fort Lowell and Country Club. The store hours are Tuesday to Friday 9:30am - 5:30pm and Saturday 9:30am - 4:00pm. They are closed on Sunday and Monday. Paula O'Dowd is the owner.

1) Book Linen: Paper Paper Paper has this available in several colors. It comes in a roll 17" x 19" and costs \$9.25. One roll should be enough to make two notebooks. For each notebook, cut one piece 13 1/4" x 10" and one piece 5/8" x 8".

2) Accent Paper: This piece needs to be 6" x9" and should coordinate/complement with your book linen color.

3) Vellum: This piece should be 12" x 7 15/16" for the envelope holder for pad of paper

You will also need: a piece of poster board 4 7/8" x 8 1/8", Exacto knife, sharp craft scissors, 12 or 15 inch ruler, paper folder, glue such as Alene's tacky glue or glue recommended by Paper Paper Paper (ask Paula O'Dowd), 1/2" paint brush to apply glue, small container/dish to hold glue, brick or several heavy books for weighing down project, emery board, your needlepoint insert piece, pad of paper 5' x 8", 1/2" thick (think office supply store). If you have one, a cutting mat is also helpful.

The Guild will supply Stitch Witchery and Nancy Eide's husband is donating the mat board and cutting it to the needed sizes. Thank you so much for that donation. We will have irons and ironing boards available too. A friend of Marge Martin's has generously donated book linen which will be available at the September and October meetings. If you would like to use this, please plan on cutting it to the necessary sizes before coming to the November meeting.

We hope you will join us in this fun project. Please let Margaret Von Kuelgelgen know at the October meeting if you will be participating.

If you have an idea for an upcoming program, please let the Vice Presidents know. We always love to hear from you.
